Your booking is made subject to the following terms and conditions;

Reservations

You must pay for your booking by credit or debit card.

Damage to rooms of a non 'wear and tear' nature will be charged for.

Prices

All rates quoted per room, per night and are inclusive of VAT, no service charges apply.

Credit Cards

You must guarantee your booking with a credit or debit card at time of booking.

Insurance

Credit Card Details

Room Prices

Cancellations/Amendments
